Garden Tours

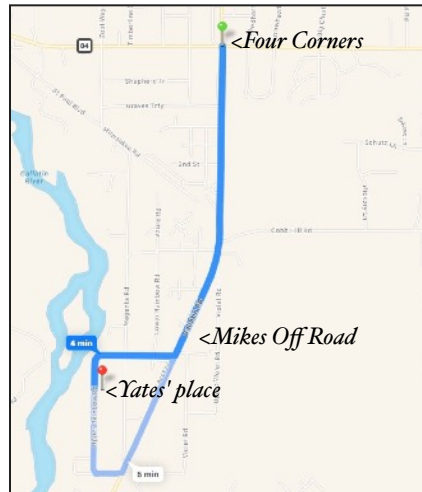

Just past Mike's Off-Road, turn right onto Upper Rainbow Road. Follow this gravel road west then south .4 miles. Yates' place will then be on your left (wood siding, metal roof, circular driveway, "3020" posted next to front door). Park in the circular driveway or

on the front lawn, and join the fun out back.
